SUBJECT: Underground Storage Tank Certification of Compliance
DATE: February 4, 2022

North Dakota state law (NDAC Article 33.1-24) requires underground storage tank (UST) owners to test the UST systems for leaks, corrosion protection, and equipment functionality. In order for the NDDEQ to monitor compliance with these rules, you are required to submit documentation showing that your tank systems have been tested in accordance with the rules.

The information must be submitted to the Department by March 15, 2022. You will not receive a Certification of Compliance Certificate if you do not send in all of the required documentation.

You are reminded that UST owners and operators must be in compliance with the State UST Rules to qualify for reimbursement from the North Dakota Petroleum Tank Release Compensation Fund in the event of a leak.
