

CHAPTER 33-16-02.1
MAXIMUM SULFATE LIMIT OF SHEYENNE RIVER

A new section is created as follows:

33-16-02.1-___. Maximum Sulfate Limit of Sheyenne River

The quality of water in the Sheyenne River shall be that of a Class IA stream, except that the maximum limit of sulfate in the segment of the Sheyenne River that runs from its headwaters to 0.1 mile downstream from the Baldhill Dam, including Lake Ashtabula, shall be 750 mg/L.
