

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS TO  
NORTH DAKOTA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE  
ARTICLE 33.1-24**

**Renotification for Small Quantity and Large Quantity Generators**

In 2016, the Federal Regulations were updated to include the new Hazardous Waste Generator Improvements Rule. The new management standards include renotifying the federal and state governments about generator status every 4 years if you are a small quantity generator or if you are a large quantity generator every even-numbered year.

The standards are listed in NDAC 33.1-24-03-03(7). The amendments aim to push renotification for small and large quantity generators, so the Department knows the current status of the facility.

**References to Reverse Distributors and Aerosol Cans were added.**

In the Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) 270.1, information about reverse distributors and a reference to aerosol cans is provided.

The change in language was added in NDAC 33.1-24-06-01 so that the Department's rules can more accurately reflect the Federal Regulations.

**Spelling Mistakes**

In administrative codes 33.1-24-05 and 33.1-24-03 there were numerous grammatical errors that were fixed.

In NDAC 33.1-24-05-311, a "does not apply" will be removed from the recall corrective action plan. This was an error that occurred in the last rule change in 2021.
