FOR A SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY UNDER

BACKGROUND:

On October 5, 2018, the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (Department) received a permit application for a renewal of the GGH North Dakota, LLC – Black Mallard Disposal’s (GGH) large volume industrial waste landfill.

GGH currently owns an unconstructed industrial waste landfill facility, regulated under Permit 0379, on approximately 240 acres (approximately 39 acres for landfill) located in the SW1/4 and the W1/2 of the SE1/4 of Section 5, Township 155 North, Range 92 West in Mountrail County, ND. GGH is proposing to renew their permit to operate a large volume industrial waste landfill. The facility was first permitted in 2015.

The Department believes that a permit which meets the requirements of the North Dakota Solid Waste Management Rules and is protective of human health and the environment can be issued to GGH North Dakota, LLC – Black Mallard Disposal and has prepared a Draft Permit for public review and comment.

PUBLIC COMMENTS AND HEARING

As required by Section 33.1-20-03.1-03 of the North Dakota Administrative Code, the Draft Permit will be available for public review and comment for thirty (30) days following publication of the Public Notice. The public comment period begins October 16, 2019 and ends November 18, 2019. During that period, any interested person may submit written comments and request a public hearing by stating the nature of the specific issues to be raised. A fifteen (15) day notice will be provided before any hearing is scheduled. The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality will consider all comments prior to taking any action on the permit.
