

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE A
RADIATION CONTROL PROGRAM
RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE TO OPERATE

Take notice that the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) proposes to issue an amendment to Baranko Environmental LLC's (Baranko) TENORM Decontamination/Decommissioning Radioactive Materials License. The amendment will add the authorization for the processing of Naturally Occurring Radioactive Material (NORM) and Technologically Enhanced Natural Occurring Radioactive Material (TENORM) at temporary job sites in North Dakota, except in areas of federal jurisdiction, in accordance with the North Dakota Radiological Health Rules. Baranko's dispatch facility is located at 3048 Highway 22, Dickinson, North Dakota 58601.

Preliminary evaluations made by NDDEQ staff indicate that Baranko will comply with all applicable North Dakota Radiological Health Rules and there will be no significant detrimental effects to members of the public or the environment.

A 30-day public comment period for the draft license will begin on March 27, 2025 and end on April 28, 2025. Comments should be directed in writing to:

Comments may also be submitted electronically to ram@nd.gov. Comments must be received by the end of the public comment period to be considered in the final license determination. A public hearing regarding issuance of the amended license will be held if a significant degree of public interest exists as determined by the NDDEQ. Requests for a public hearing must be received in writing by the NDDEQ before the end of the public comment period.
